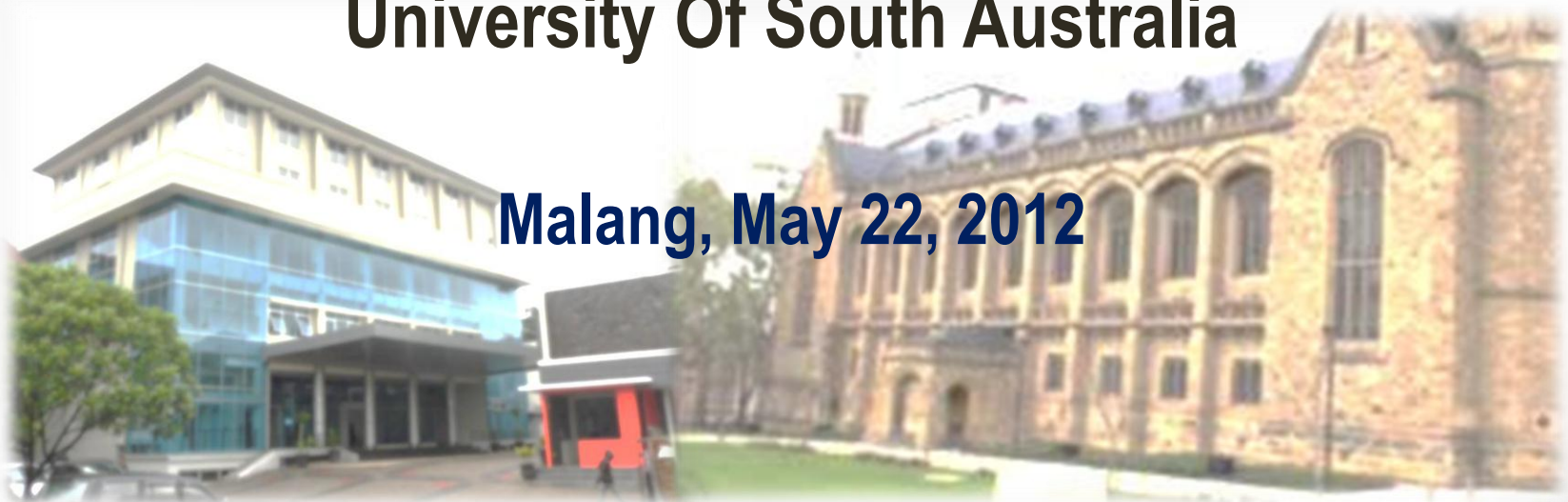

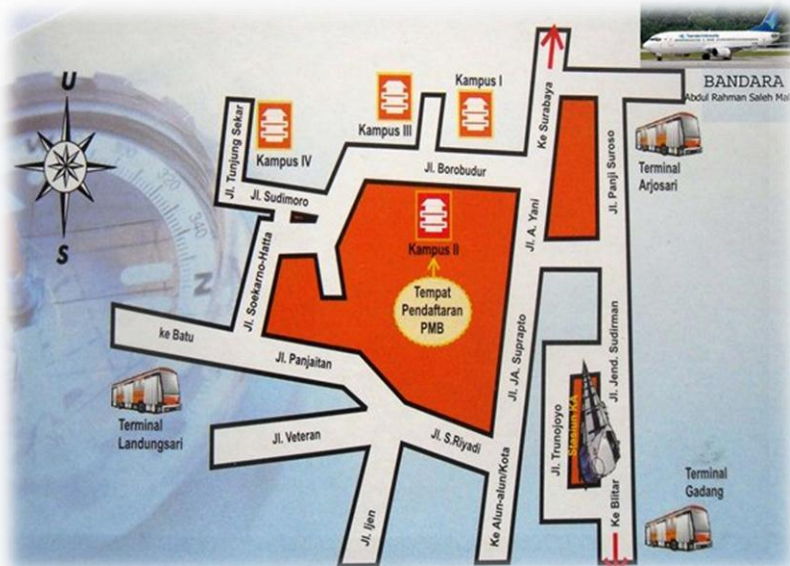

Malang City & Campus environment

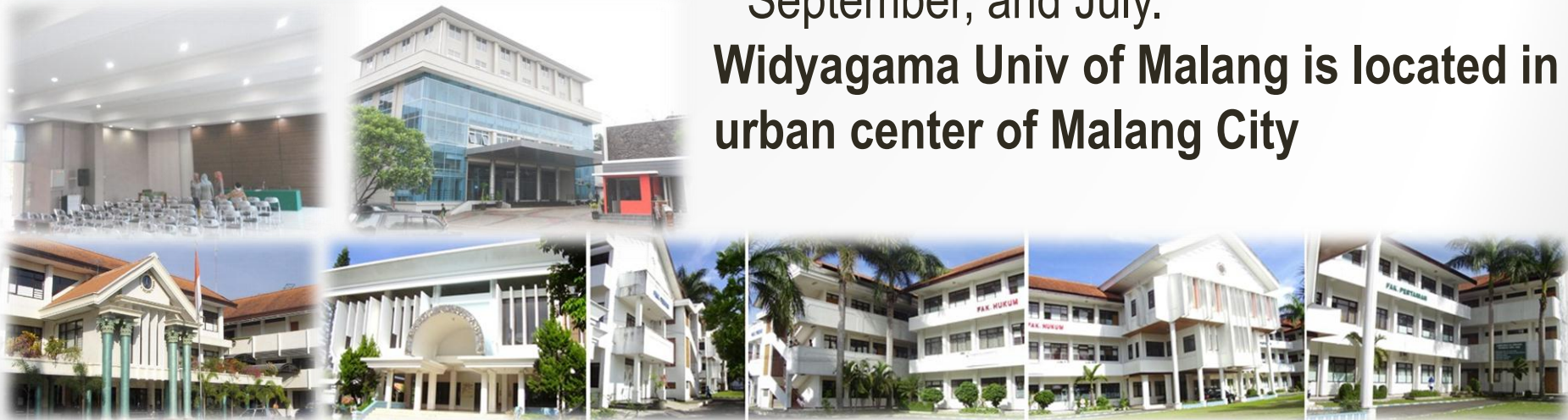


Malang is a comfortable city, also called as the city of flowers, Paris van Java, tourism city, education city, industrial city

- 1971: Widyagama University of Malang was established, by a foundation named Yayasan Pembina Pendidikan Indonesia (YPPI); Originally, it was Widyagama School of Banking
- 1980: Widyagama School of Management and Accounting
- 1985: Widyagama University of Malang, **4 Faculty**: Economics, Law, Agriculture and Technology; and **10 Study Program**: Management, Accounting, Law Legal, Agronomy, Food Technology, Agribusiness, Mechanical, Civil and Electrical Engineering.

1. Leadership is the leadership's commitment to implement the vision in the improvement of academic quality
2. Relevance is efforts of quality improvement by identification of stakeholder needs through curriculum development and cooperation.
3. Academic Atmosphere is the effort to improve the quality and academic interaction in the academic rules and framework
4. Internal Management and Organization is the efforts to realize the commitment and improvement of higher education management.
5. Sustainability is the effort to put long-term planning and policy
6. Efficiency and productivity is to increase the efficiency and output of quality academic activities

- ❑ 90 administrative personnels (technician, operator, librarian, clerk etc)



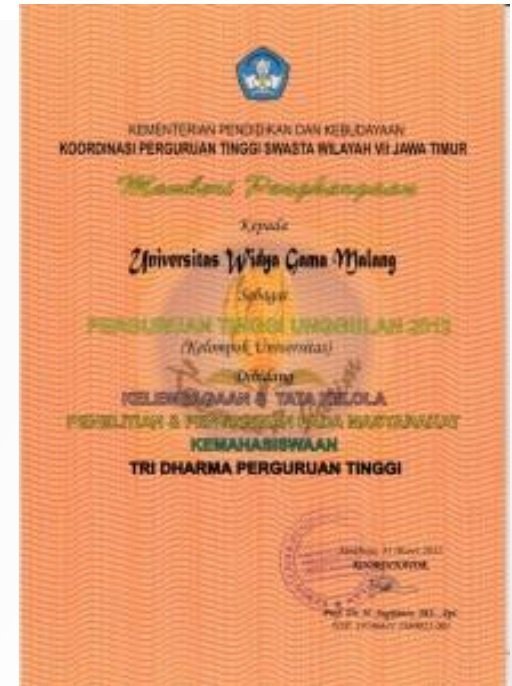
the results achieved
